#### <u>CHAPTER 5</u> <u>VESSEL EXAMINATION</u> <u>AND</u> MARINE DEALER VISITATION PROGRAMS

#### A. Vessel Examiner (VE) Program.

- 1. <u>Initial Qualification.</u>
  - a. <u>Member Action.</u> Member must pass the VE open book examination, and perform five (5) **VSCs** under the instruction of a qualified Vessel Examiner. The observer VE will document the five examinations/inspections by signing off on the "Qualification and Requalification" form (D11NR Form MT-2).
  - b. <u>FSO-MT Action.</u> The FSO-MT will record the test score, sign the CCGD11NR Form MT-2 and submit it together with the "Examination Answer Sheet", Form CG-4886 (ANSC 7010), to DIRAUX.
  - c. <u>DIRAUX Action</u>. DIRAUX will make appropriate entries into AUXDATA and will forward the appropriate certificate, letter, ribbon and miniature medal to the Flotilla Commander. A copy of the letter will be sent to DSO-VE.

## 2. <u>Re-Qualification.</u>

- a. <u>FSO-MT Action.</u> The FSO-MT will enter the test score, sign the CCGD11NR Form, MT-2 and submit it together with the "Examination Answer Form CG-4886 (ANSC 7010)) to DIRAUX. The FSO-MT will also verify that the member attended an approved VE Seminar/Workshop **if required for the required year.**
- b. <u>DIRAUX Action</u>. Notification will be sent to the member via the chain of responsibility with a copy to DSO-VE and DSO-MT.

## B. Marine Dealer Visitation (MV) Program.

- 1. <u>Initial Qualification.</u>
  - a. <u>Member and Flotilla Commander Action.</u> The member must complete an approved boating safety course and pass the current MV qualification examination (1-hour open book, 90% passing score), make two (2) Marine Visits with a currently qualified Marine Visitor and complete the District 11NR Qualification and Recertification Form MT-2 and submit it

to the FC for endorsement. The FC will forward the application together with the Examination Answer Sheet, Form CG-4886 (ANSC 7010), to DIRAUX for approval.

- b. <u>DIRAUX Action.</u> Upon approval, DIRAUX will forward the appropriate certificate, letter, Examiner ribbon, and miniature medal (3/16" bronze star in lieu of ribbon and medal, if candidate has already been certified as VE or CFVE) to the member via the FC. A copy of the letter will be sent to DSO-MV.
- c. <u>DSO-MV Action.</u> Upon receipt of the certification letter from DIRAUX, the DSO-MV will send a "Cooperating Marine Dealer" decal and marine dealer information package, to the new MV.
- 2. <u>Re-Qualification.</u>
  - a. Each member who initially qualifies will be exempt from attending a required approved workshop during that calendar year. All requalification requirements apply after the year of initial qualification.
  - b. A Marine Dealer Visitor may annually retain qualification by fulfilling the following requirements.
    - (1) Perform at least 4 Marine Visits.
    - (1) Attend a Headquarters approved VE/MV workshop, if mandated.
  - c. A Marine Visitor who did not maintain his MV qualification may requalify, if the following requirements are met.
    - (1) Have MV activities in the last 5 years.
    - (2) Complete one (1) Marine Visit with a currently qualified Marine Visitor.
    - (3) Complete the District 11NR Qualification and Recertification Form MT-2, and submit it to FC for endorsement. FC will forward the application to DIRAUX for recertification approval. DIRAUX will forward recertification letter to the member, via FC. A copy of the letter will also be sent to DSO-MV.

# C. Ordering of Forms and Pamphlets.

- 1. VE's must order all necessary **VSC** forms and pamphlets through their Flotilla Staff Officer, Materials (FSO-MA). VE's requiring **VSC** decals should order them directly from the DSO-VE.
- 2. The VE shall destroy any unused, outdated decals upon receipt of the current decals.
- 3. Forms, and any Coast Guard boating safety pamphlets must be ordered from the Auxiliary National Supply Center (ANSC) by the FSO-MA. The DSO-MV will only supply "Cooperating Marine Dealer" decals to MV's.
