Technical PITFALLS

- Blockage & Filters
 A message sent is not always received.
- Spam
 Report spam to ISP while on the web.
- Security Email is like a postcard, visible in transmission
- Forgery, Spoofing, and Phishing Email mischief which could by malicious
- Listing Addresses on the Web Suggest using: www.gmail.com

Best Practices for Auxiliary Fmail

- Maintain current email address in AUXDATA.
- We do not send chain letters, jokes, or other unrelated AUX business
- Politics or sexually oriented content do not belong
- Follow the Chain of Leadership

COURTESIES and ETIQUETTE

Internet technology provides Auxiliary members an additional way to communicate. With concerns of privacy and security, it is important to observe general guidelines of etiquette.

Misunderstandings occur in most types of communication. Nevertheless, it is possible to repair glitches in a face-to-face dialog or telephone conversation before any lasting damage occurs.

The following guidelines for email etiquette will help Auxiliary members:

- convey a professional image within and outside the Auxiliary
- communicate what is intended and avoid misunderstanding
- be aware any message sent is permanent and referred to later

Best Practices

D11NR Distribution List

Sending Effective Messages

Target your audiences when selecting language and style. Identify yourself and your position clearly. Use clear and meaningful subject lines that your reader will understand.

Separate opinion from facts to promotes clear understanding.

Avoid messages to multiple administrative levels when communication on a single level is appropriate. Limit the list of recipients and Cc:'s only to the people who are directly involved with the subject. When referring to another member's involvement, always copy the member.

For mass e-mailings use the Bcc: field (Blind copy).

Do not copy or forward a message or attachments without the author's permission.
