- Egress (aircraft)
- Communications
- Navigation
- Weather Information
- Aircraft Systems
- Mission/Flight Planning
- Communication Logs (SAR a priority)

Navigation-Aviation & Marine

- Aircraft Sectional Charts Required
- Marine Charts Required
- Use of navigation eqpt.-GPS or LORAN
- Translate location to either map
- Examples-SFO Sectional, San Francisco Bay



ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS-ALL AVIATORS

- Swim Test
- Attend one safety seminar
- Egress Training
- Observers-3 patrols every 6 months-rec.

PILOTS

- Pilots-3 patrols as PIC every 6 months
- Medical-3rd class or above
- SAR/STAN Check-every 2 years
- Log Book Review

OBSERVER REQUIREMENTS-

- Reco. by First Pilot or A/C Commander
- Basic Qualified& approved boating course
- Pass 50 yd. Swim test-before first flight
- Score 90% min. on Observers test
- Observer Trainee for min. 10 hours (w/supervision)
- Demonstrate USCG Comm. Procedures
- Complete Area Familiarity training
- Observer syllabus signed-off and approved
