Members of the Past Commanders Association, in good standing, are exempt from the fee but still need to register for the classes. Please check this box if you are a current member of the PCA :

Appropriate uniforms will be decided by instructors. Applicants (new, waiting fingerprint clearance) wear appropriate civilian attire. Must have Photo ID, proof of car insurance and vehicle registration to be able to gain entrance to Coast Guard Island with vehicle. **Speed limit: 20 MPH over bridge, through gate and on base.** No cell phone use while driving or walking. Be sure to have your AUX ID card with you for admittance to the Galley. Tobacco use, including chew tobacco, is prohibited in all government owned or leased vehicles - including Cushman-type carts, in all buildings and all outdoor areas except those designated by signs as tobacco-use areas. This policy applies to civilians as well as active duty personnel. ISCALAINST 6280.1B (Tobacco Use on Coast Guard Island) identifies designated smoking areas.

All students and instructors meet in the Gresham Hall at 0715 the morning of your first class.
