PEPIRB s & PPE ASSIGNED TO MEMBER FROM THE COAST GUARD:

The following are the pprocedures for Acquiring an EPIRB (Personal **Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon**)

After becoming qualified as a Coxswain contact the DIRAUX office and provide them with your member number, full actual name and address to which PEPIRB needs to be mailed. After receiving this information the DIRAUX office will write the basic information on a form and send with the PEPIRB to the member. Upon completing the form, member must contact McMurdo and register the device. After the device is registered McMurdo will send member registration information. **YOU MUST SEND A COPY OF THIS INFORMATION TO THE DIRAUX OFFICE.** If for any reason you decide you no longer wish to be a Coxswain or you plan to get out of the Auxiliary or transfer; member must unregister the device with McMurdo and send it back into the DIRAUX office. All EPIRB's must be returned to the office, please do not switch or give anyone else your EPIRB.

If a member in your flotilla plans to leave the auxiliary, transfer or has passed away; you must send all DIRAUX-issued Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) gear back to the DIRAUX office. **DO NOT** trade items if they are too small or too large please contact the DIRAUX office and the member will be issued the proper size or make other issuing arrangements. If the gear is not

returned to the DIRAUX office the member or the Flotilla Commander will be held responsible. All Flotilla Commanders, please ensure that your members are returning all gear when it is no longer needed or unserviceable.

FACILITY OWNERS WHO ARE NOT COXSWAINS OR CREW:

Auxiliary members who are not Crew or Coxswain qualified can make their vessels Facilities and be on the vessel as guest or trainee during patrols as long as all other requirements are met (qualified Crew and Coxswains). Either the owner or the Coxswain (operator) can request and be reimbursed for the patrol. If the owner would like to be the one reimbursed please contact me so I can put the necessary information into POMS so he/she can request orders and fill out the 5132. Also be certain to fill out the direct deposit form at:

https://www.fincen.uscg.mil/secure/enrollment_form.htm.

The the only way you will be reimbursed for the patrol is if you have the direct deposit form on file with FINCEN. You are also reimbursed for Standard Auxiliary Maintenance Allowance (SAMA). This reimbursement, when funds are available, depends upon horsepower, time underway and number of engines. Below is the current rate for reimbursement for meals:

BREAKFAST	LUNCH	DINNER
0400 TO 0800 = \$2.45	1000 to 1400 = \$4.55	1600 to 2000 = \$4.55

You should not request reimbursement if you do not supply meals, just be certain to advise your crew to bring the necessary meals if you do not plan to feed them. Be certain to always turn in all original receipts (fuel, oil, ice, or???) pertaining to the patrol along with a copy of the 7030 and 5132 to your Order Issuing Authority.
