Students who complete the new ATON Verifier PQS during this course will be able to sign off new verifiers. <b>(ATON) Verifier PQS Qualification &amp; Certification Course</b>	SUN all-day	This course is for members wishing to qualify as an Auxiliary Aid to Navigation (ATON) Verifier. <b>Boat Crew Academy</b> <b>PRE-REQ: ICS 100 &amp; 700, and a NASBLA approved boating class</b>	2-DAY CLASS: BOTH SAT & SUN	This class is intended for members with a sincere interest in meeting the requirements for Crew, Coxswain or PWC Operator certification. Will include swim test if pool available. <b>(No skills will be signed off during class except the swim test)</b> <span style="float: right;">Instructors: Gail Ramsey</span>
<b>Coastie Training</b>	SUN PM	This class is mandatory if you would like to use "Coastie" at boat shows, parades, or your PA events. <span style="float: right;">Instructor: Phillip Grove</span>
<b>Dockwalkers</b>	SAT AM 10:00-12:10	Learn about potential sources of boat pollution, their impact, environmental regulations and clean boating practices that prevent these potential sources. <b>Ferry Vessel Examiner course</b>	SAT AM 08:00-10:00	Initial training for those interested in becoming Ferry Boat Auditors as well as Annual Requalification. <span style="float: right;">Instructor: Abigail Wagg</span>
<b>Flotilla Leadership Course</b>	2-DAY CLASS: BOTH SAT & SUN	This course provides potential Flotilla Commanders with the organizational framework and resources to successfully manage their Flotillas. The FLC may be used to satisfy current requirements to stand for election, and meets the Leadership Course requirement for AUXOP status <span style="float: right;">Instructor: Wally Smith</span>
<b>GoodMate Course</b>	SUN PM	This is the first course required for the Marine Safety Ribbon. It was developed by the Ocean Conservancy and is designed to encourage ocean and waterway conservation by boaters. <span style="float: right;">Instructor: Dale Fajardo</span>
<b>HAZWHOPER</b>	SAT PM	This training is designed to meet the requirements of CFR 1910.120(q), the Hazwoper regulation, for EMERGENCY RESPONSE to a potential or actual release of hazardous substances or a discharge of oil. Provides an understanding of what hazardous substances are, and the risks associated with them. Understand your role in the response plan. <span style="float: right;">Instructor: Wil Sumner</span>
<b>ICS 210 – 4 hr class</b>	SAT AM	Mandatory ICS Class for those members who perform certain tasks. Take advantage of this excellent opportunity. <span style="float: right;">Instructor: Jerry Bynum</span>
<b>Intro to Waterways Management</b>	SUN AM	The Introduction to Waterways Management course will give an overview of how the U.S. Coast Guard helps to manage federal waterways and ensures the safety of the boating public through Aids to Navigation, Harbor Patrols, the Vessel Traffic System, etc.. <b>New Member Orientation Course</b>	Saturday	A "must" course for new Auxiliarists! Includes discussions about uniforms, protocols, Auxiliary offices, opportunities, DIRAUX, Chain of Leadership and other topics. <b>Prevention Outreach Specialist (MEES) PQS</b>	SAT PM	This course will provide an overview and the materials required to complete one of the new Performance Qualification Standards (PQS) for the Marine Safety Program. <span style="float: right;">Instructors: Sue Fry &amp; Simone Adair</span>
<b>Proctored Exams</b>	SAT 07-1400	This is your opportunity to be proctored for an exam. Let us know what exam, and what time you want to start, and we will have the exam and proctor waiting for you! <span style="float: right;">Proctor: TBD</span>
<b>Program Visitor</b>	SUN AM	Review and Test. Study material must be read prior to class. Manuals needed: RBSVP # M16796.C & VSC # M16796.8 <span style="float: right;">Instructor: Phillip Grove</span>
<b>TCT – (8hr) Team Coordination Training</b>	Sunday	Be sure to check your due date for this important class. Required for operations initially and every five years. <span style="float: right;">Instructor: Jim Blackburn</span>
<b>Vessel Examiner</b>	2-DAY CLASS: BOTH SAT & SUN	Receive 2 days training and then take the written test. After this class, you will need to do the 5 practical Vessel Safety Checks with a qualified VE to become VE qualified.
