AUXDATA & CREW/COXSWAINS/PWCs:

How soon we forget. We have had a flurry of Coxswains unable to complete their orders because they or their needed qualified Crew, have become REYR. Please communicate with your IS Officers and verify your crew are current prior to getting underway and process your orders as soon as possible after the patrol so you are reimbursed in a timely manner. Your NAV-Rules now expire 5 years from the date you took them, not the end of the year. This is slipping by many Coxswains. So if you did a patrol the 31st of May, your NAV Rules expired the 3rd of June and you did not process your orders until the 20th of June, your orders could not be processed.

DELTA AND ELSEWHERE BOATING CAUTIONS:

The quasi-annual barriers closing some waterways in the Delta is being implemented again this year. For a list of where the barriers are and dates, check the California Department of Waterways web site, starting with the schedule at:

With many lakes being very low this year, it is also expected that many boaters will be bringing their boats to the Delta or even SF Bay and the coast. We should be aware and watch for boaters who may not be very aware of local hazards, nor accustomed to the tides and currents they do not experience in lake boating.

FEMA COURSES (ICS COURSES):

All members who take the FEMA classes on line please remember that the completion of these on-line courses will not automatically show in AUXDATA for your individual records. The only way for these classes to show is for DIRAUX office personnel to insert manually into AUXDATA. Therefore you must send a copy of completion notification to: D11-SMB-D11AUX-Northern (DIRAUX Email). There are several FEMA ICS courses that are required tasks for several of our AUX missions and members cannot be certified until these courses are completed. Also QEs should not get underway with a candidate unless the required ICS courses are completed.

FACILITY OWNERS/COXSWAINS:

Be certain the Coxswains and Owners have their EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) filled out and sent to Coast Guard Finance at least two weeks prior to any planned patrols. Both owners and Coxswains are required to have valid Auxdata Order Management System (AOM) accounts prior to requesting orders and need to know how to use AOM to request orders and complete claims.

OPTREXs & OPEXs, PLEASE PREPARE:

A reminder to those organizing OPS events to please send me all needed info (candidates, member number, qualification requested, facilities, Coxswains of record, etc.) in a timely manner (at least three weeks prior). Coxswains must request orders at least two weeks ahead of the event date and ensure the facilities are ready, and participants should practice ahead of time to be ready. It is very unfair and our candidates are set up to fail without adequate time and training on the Facilities.
