Your Flotilla Commander is responsible that all candidate tasks are completed before a Qualification Examiner is requested. If the candidate will be attending another event, your Flotilla Commander should pass all supporting documents (including signoff manual or copies) to the person who will be verifying the qualifications and turning in the request to the QE Coordinator. The event organizer will be requesting the Qualification Examiner(s). Only one person should be requesting QEs for each event. All names should be submitted at least 30 days in advance and all candidates should have all their mandatory tasks completed.

Antlers Resort is located 23 miles North of Redding on I-5, on the Sacramento Arm of Shasta Lake. Take the I-5 Exit #702 (Antlers Road Exit), Lakeshore Dr.

RV Park/Trailer Rentals: RV spaces with full hookups are available for \$15 per night. If you don't have an RV, travel trailers can be rented for \$65 per night, including space. There are also tent sites for \$15, as well as showers, washers and dryers. For more information, go to <http://antlersrvpark.com/>. There is a special rate for Coast Guard. Cabins: There are a limited number of cabins available. A \$50 deposit is required to reserve one. If you rent a cabin, tell them you are with the Coast Guard and don't wait until the last minute because they will go fast. Miscellaneous resources: There is a mini mart at the Shell station, a small supermarket, and a couple of little cafes and bars in Lakehead. Major resources are in Redding, about 30 minutes south on I-5.

Fishing: is great this time of the year - Rainbow, German Brown, Kamloops, Bass, Sturgeon, and land-locked Salmon up to 15 pounds. A California State Fishing license is required.

Kayaking: The resort has some kayaks for rent or bring your own.

Biking and walking trails are abundant in this area. Dogs are welcome, but must be on a leash in the campground and you must pick up after pets.
